Texas Appleseed's Scholarship Available to Help Fulfill Dreams of Law School

Deadline Approaching to Apply for Diversity Legal Scholars Scholarship

AUSTIN, Texas — Texas Appleseed, a public interest justice center, is accepting scholarship applications as part of its Diversity Legal Scholars program, aimed at diversifying the legal profession. The program helps low-income students of color expand their law school options through a scholarship that covers the full cost of a Kaplan (LSAT) preparation course.

The scholarship is available three times a year, and this is the second round of 2017. Key dates are below:

- Round 2: Application deadline is June 30, 2017. The LSAT test date for this round is on/around September 16, 2017.
- Round 3: Application deadline is September 29, 2017. The LSAT test date for this
 round is on/around December 2, 2017.

Scholarship recipients must be a Texas resident and apply to take the LSAT on the designated date that corresponds to their Application Round. Additional requirements and details can be found at www.texasappleseed.org/diversity-legal-scholars.
