

Hurricane Fiona: Applications for Individual Assistance - 10/8/2022

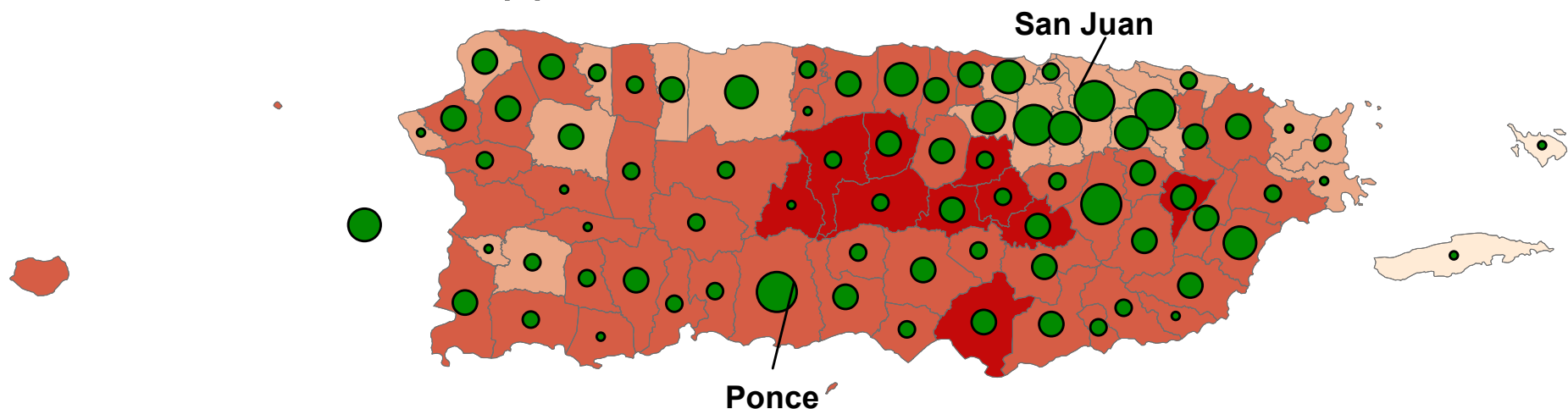


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 1, 2022

Assistance received:

Have received Critical Needs Assistance (\$700): 465,827

Have received Other Needs Assistance more than \$700: 11,659

Have received Housing Assistance: 4,695

- 775,891 applications is equal to 89 applications per 100 Households.

- 10 municipios have exceeded more recorded more applications than the total number of households, including Salinas and the inland municipios of Barranquitas, Cidra, Comerio, Jayuya, Naranjito, and Orocovis, Morovis, Ciales, and Juncos.

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

40,213 inspections have been performed. although almost 30% of these have been in the San Juan metro area. None of the heavily affected interior counties have had more than 700 inspections.

- 47% of applicants have been found to be eligible for an assistance. Of these, 97% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

- Of the 41,000 determinations for housing assistance, fewer than 5,000 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.

- 3,864 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 1 in 10 total applications.
