


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Inspections per 100 Applications as of February 18, 2023

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

- 59% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 68% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 298,809 determinations for housing assistance, 16,697 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 19,132 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 6% of all determinations
- -26,617 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for no contact for inspection, 9% of all determinations
