


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Housing Assistance Referrals per 100 Applications as of January 14, 2023






- 1,239,069 applications is equal to 103 applications per 100 households.
- 61 municipios have recorded more applications than the estimated total number of households

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

- 293,783 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 24% of total applicants.
- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 69% received \$700, the default award per 100 applications
- Of the 290,374 determinations for housing assistance, 13,397 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 16,535 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 6% of all determinations
- -16% of applicants require special accommodations
