


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of January 7, 2023

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

--291,743 applicants gave been referred for housing assistance, 24% of total applications

- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 288,464 determinations for housing assistance, 12,772 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 15,914 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 6% of all determinations
- -16% of applicants require special accommodations
