

Hurricane Fiona: Applications for Individual Assistance - 10/15/2022

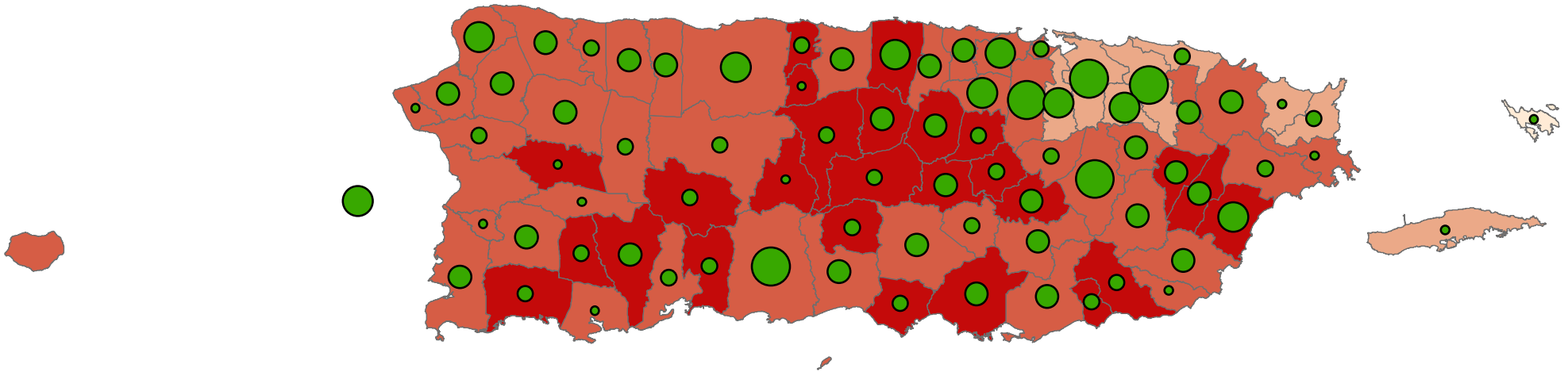


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 15, 2022

Total Applications: 1,088,700
Applications in the last week: 101,282

Total Inspections: 59,341
Inspections in the last week: 19,128
Housing Assistance Referrals: 223,038

Assistance received
Have received Critical Needs Assistance (\$700): 565,109
Have received Other Needs Assistance (more than \$700): 18,010
Have received Housing Assistance: 6,623

- 1,088,700 applications is equal to 90 applications per 100 households.

- 26 municipios have recorded more applications than the estimated total number of households

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

- 223,308 applicants have been referred to the housing assistance program (22%) of total.

- 54% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 96% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

- Of the 57,000 determinations for housing assistance, fewer than 7,000 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.

- 6,773 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 12% of all determinations
