


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 22, 2022

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

-246,402 applicants have been referred for housing assistance. 22% of total applicants.

- 57% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 96% received \$700, the default award Legend for Critical Needs Assistance.

- Of the 69,106 determinations for housing assistance, 7,384 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 7,799 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 11% of all determinations
