

# Hurricane Fiona: Applications for Individual Assistance - 10/29/2022

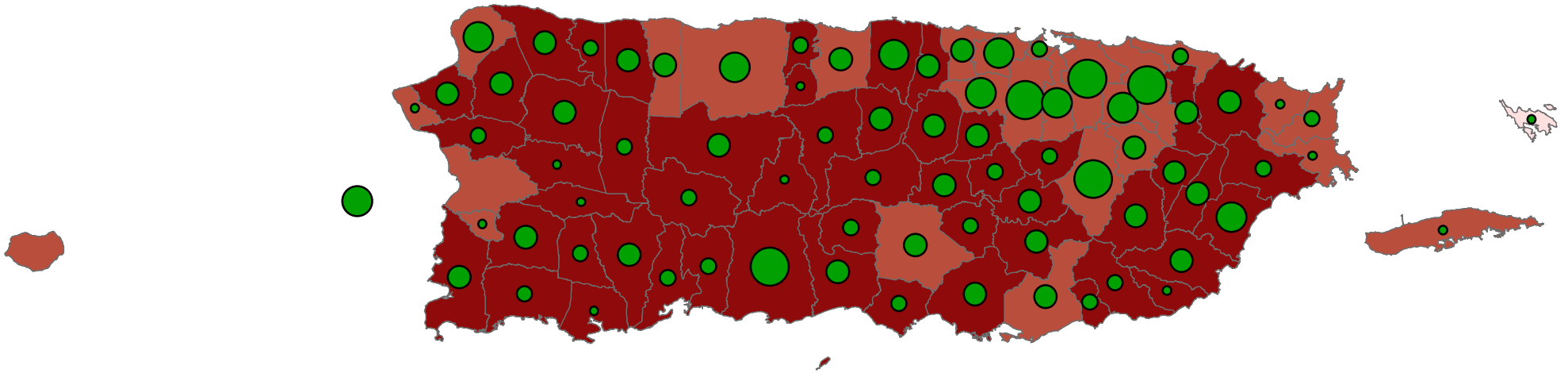


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 29, 2022

**Total Applications: 1,195,176 Applications in the last week: 41,548**

**Housing Referrals: 256,889**

**Housing Referrals in the last week: 10,487**

**Total Inspections: 82,756 Inspections in the last week: 9,889**

**Assistance received**

**Have received Critical Needs Assistance (\$700): 497,286**

**Have received Other Needs Assistance (more than \$700): 160,365**

**Have received Housing Assistance: 7,935**

- 1,153,628 applications is equal to 99 applications per 100 households.

- 54 municipios have recorded more applications than the estimated total number of households

-Culebra had the lowest rate of applications with 53 applications per 100 households.

**Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards**

-256,889 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 22% of total applications

- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 72% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

- Of the 234,979 determinations for housing assistance, 7,935 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.

- 8,491 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 4% of all determinations
