


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of November 26, 2022

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

-274,767 applicants gave been referred for housing assistance, 22% of total applications

- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 269,213 determinations for housing assistance, 9,643 applicant have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 11,024 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 4% of all determinations
- -16% of applicants require special accommodations
