


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of November 5, 2022

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

-264,562 applicants gave been referred for housing assistance, 22% of total applications

- 57% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 71% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 256,515 determinations for housing assistance,8,473 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 9,044 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 4% of all determinations
