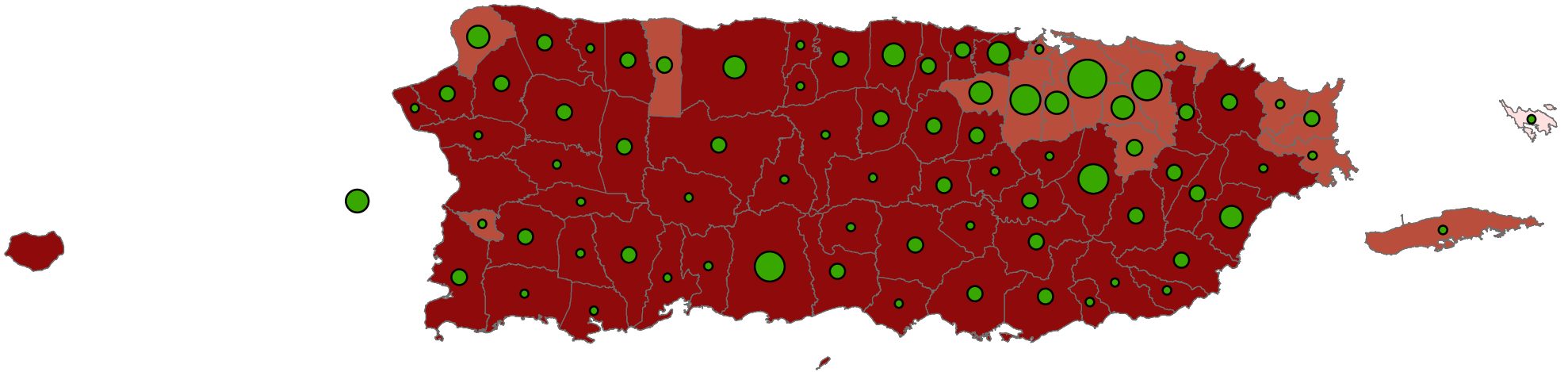


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of December 10, 2022

 - 61 municipios have recorded more applications than the estimated total number of households

-Culebra had the lowest rate of applications with 57 applications per 100 households.

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

-286,332 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 22% of total applications

- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 70% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

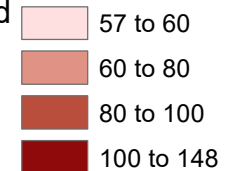
- Of the 280,220 determinations for housing assistance, 11,176 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.

- 13,490 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 5% of all determinations

-16% of applicants require special accommodations
