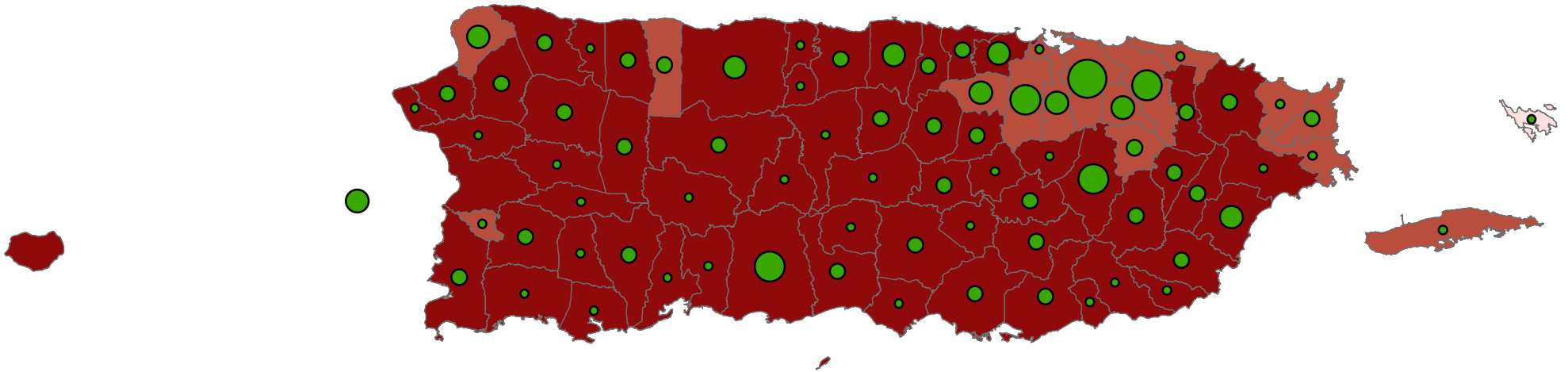


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of December 3, 2022

Assistance received

Have received Critical Needs Assistance (\$700): 505,946

Have received Other Needs Assistance (more than \$700): 167,049

Have received Housing Assistance: 10,222

- 1,238,160 applications is equal to 103 applications per 100 households.

- 61 municipios have recorded more applications than the estimated total number of households

-Culebra had the lowest rate of applications with 57 applications per 100 households.

Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

--285,472 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 23% of total applications

- 58% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 71% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

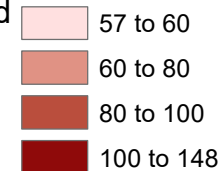
- Of the 274,045 determinations for housing assistance, 10,222 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.

- 11,874 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 4% of all determinations

-16% of applicants require special accommodations
