


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Inspections per 100 Applications as of February 11, 2023

- -298,363 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 24% of total applicants.



Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

- 59% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 68% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 298,363 determinations for housing assistance, 16,242 applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 18,919 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 6% of all determinations
- 26,606 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for no contact for inspection, 9% of all determinations
