


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Housing Assistance Referrals per 100 Applications as of February 4, 2023


- -16% of applicants require special accommodations
- -297,970 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 24% of total applicants.


Inspections, Eligibility, and Awards

- 59% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 69% received \$700, the default award Legend for Critical Needs Assistance.
- Of the 296,685 determinations applicants have received some sort of housing assistance.
- 18,593 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 6% of all determinations
- -26,616 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for no contact for inspection, 9% of all determinations
