

# Hurricane Ian: Applications for Individual Assistance - 10/15/2022

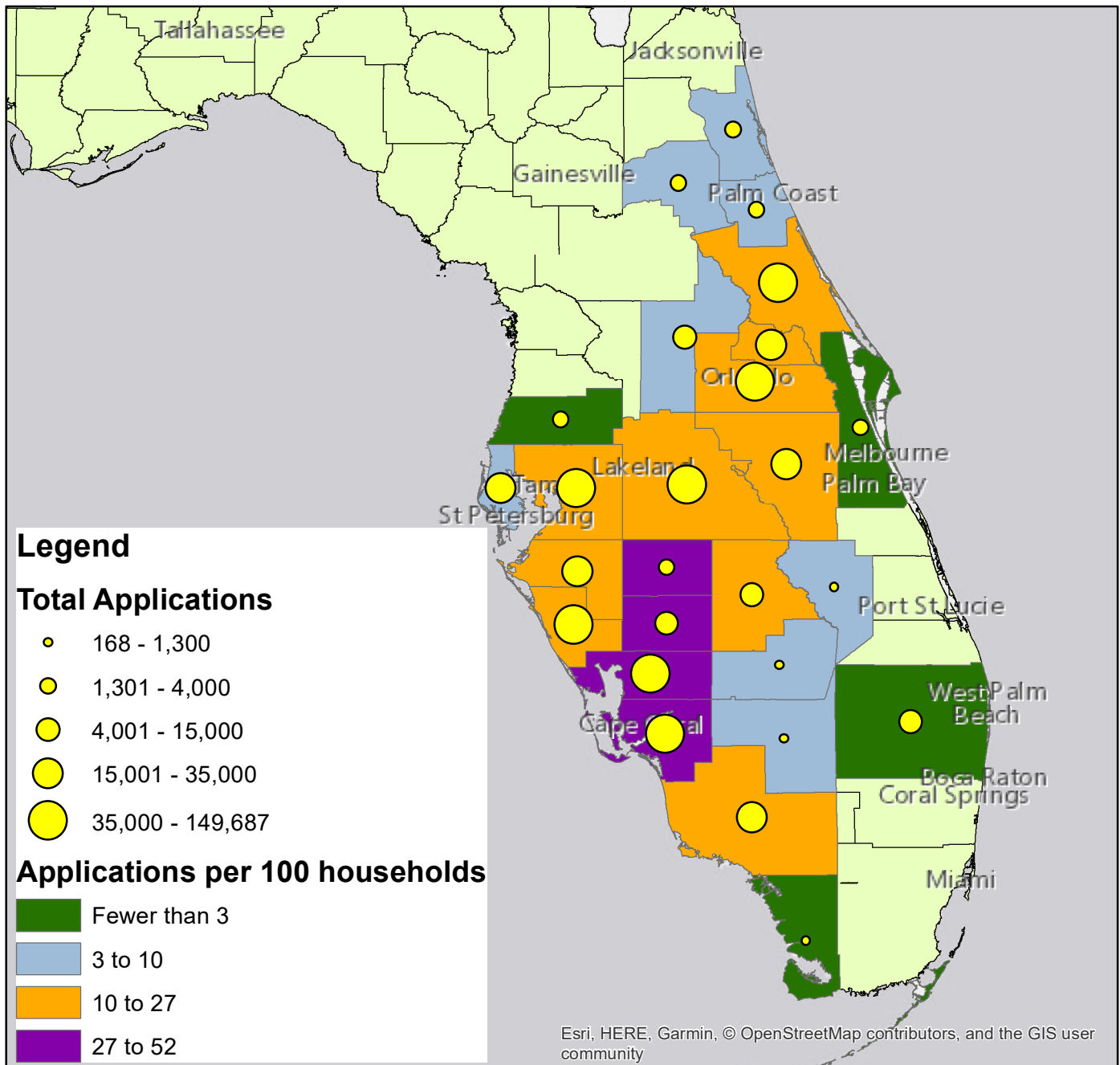


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 15, 2022

**Total Applications: 568,061**

**Applications in the last week: 210,921**

**Total Inspections: 64,992**

**Inspections in the last week: 48,562**

**Housing Assistance Referrals: 346,335**

**Assistance received**

**Have received Critical Needs Assistance (\$700): 185,016**

**Have received Other Needs Assistance (more than \$700): 11,084**

**Have received Housing Assistance: 24,803**

- 346,335 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 60% of the total.

- Overall, there are 12.7 applications for every 100 households.

- Lee, Volusia, and Orange counties had the most inspections with Lee County accounting for 36% of all inspections

- 36% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 92% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.
