


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of October 29, 2022

- 455,622 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 58% of the total. -42% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 66% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

-There were 41 applications from Indian Reservations (not pictured in map): Big Cypress Indian Reservation, Brighton Indian Reservation, Fort Pierce Indian Reservation, Hollywood Indian Reservation, Immokalee Indian Reservation, and Tampa Reservation. Tampa Reservation had the most with 31 applications.
