
Hurricane lan: Applications for Individual Assistance - 10/8/2022

Lee - 103,208 applications (35.72/100 households) Charlotte - 26,784 applications (33.56/100 households)

Desoto - 4,149 applications (33.40/100 households) Hardee - 7,911 applications (28.89/100 households)

Notes:

- The Tampa and Orlando areas recorded huge numbers of applications, but fewer per household than Fort Myers/Cape Coral.

- Overall, there are 10.7 applications for every 100 households.
- In the most heavily affected counties, applications from renters are proportionately represented. In Tampa and Orlando, renters are overrepresented.
- Mobile Homes are proportionate to total housing stock.
- Volusia, Orange, and Lee Counties have had the most inspections with more than 2,600 each.
- Charlotte and Hardee have had only 70 and 79 inspections, respectively.
- 55,000 applications for housing assistance have been initially denied because the applicant has homeowner insurance.
