


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of November 12, 2022

-40% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 65% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

-There were 39 applications from Indian Reservations (not pictured in map): Big Cypress Indian Reservation, Brighton Indian Reservation, Fort Pierce Indian Reservation, Hollywood Indian Reservation, Immokalee Indian Reservation, and Tampa Reservation. Tampa Reservation had the most with 29 applications.
