


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of November 26, 2022

- 507,036 applicants have been referred for housing assistance, 57% of the total.
- 40% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 64% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance.

- There was 1 application from Tampa Reservation (not pictured in map).

- 15% of applicants require special accommodations.

- 4,010 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 1% of all determinations
