


Figure: Map of Total Individual Assistance Applications and Applications per Household as of December 31, 2022

-526,470 applicants have been referred -for housing assistance, 58% of the total. -41% of applicants have been found to be eligible for assistance. Of these 63% received \$700, the default award for Critical Needs Assistance. -There was 1 application from Tampa Reservation (not pictured in map). -16% of applicants require special accommodations. -4,458 applications have been rejected in part or in whole for proof of ownership issues, 1% of all determinations
